## Notices

**Health Records/Immunizations:** Please send in a current Health Record and Physical Examination Form, including all immunizations to the Health Office ASAP! Your health records should be updated annually and dated within 12 months of the start of school or your child's birthday, whichever is more current. The FACTS Family Portal (on-line) Emergency Contact Information and Health Information forms must be completed at the beginning of each school year and updated as new health issues arise.

**Medications:** MA Department of Public Health requires a physician's order for all prescription and over the counter medications to be administered at school. If your child needs any medication during the school day the family is required to supply the medication ordered and it MUST be in the original container accompanied with a signed and dated physician's order and parent/guardian consent forms.

**Medication orders must be renewed yearly by your child's physician.**
